

Community Center Director Report – June 13, 2017

The Bethlehem Township Community Center (BTCC) welcomed the summer of 2017 with a flurry of fun filled activities and events over the last month. The Kid's Triathlon was conducted on Sunday, June 4th. Nearly 75 future swimmers, runners, and bikers participated in the successful family event. Camp Groundhog (BTCC's full day camp) began on Monday, June 12th with a full roster of 60 children. The Summer Playground Program is set to begin Monday, June 19th. We have over 500 children registered for the 8 week season. Participants utilize Comer Park, Chetwyn Park, and Municipal Park as well as attend several field trips throughout the summer. Once again, they will be roller skating at skate-a-way.

BTCC's outdoor pool opened on Saturday, May 27th with less than desirable swimming weather. The unfortunate rain caused early closures throughout the Holiday weekend. The quick change in temperatures tested our lifeguards when outside temps reached over 90 degrees in early June. The outdoor pool is open daily, 12pm-8pm weather permitting. The indoor pool was no stranger to crowds as our Blue Sharks swim team began practice on Monday, June 12th. We currently have approximately 50 children rostered on the team, with a few more still registering.
