MANPOWER REPORT:

- An officer was injured while on-duty when his patrol vehicle struck a stationary object in a parking lot. The surgery was unsuccessful and he underwent a second procedure in mid-October. He is scheduled to return to light duty on February 1st.
- Andrew Kanaskie and Larissa Reggetto were approved by the BOC for appointment to the department. They have completed the required physical and psychological testing and are scheduled to begin working with a field training officer on January 11, 2016.
- Gretchen Kraemer began her service with the department on December 7, 2015.
- A patrol officer who is also a member of the Pennsylvania Air National Guard remains on activate duty and will be absent from duty until mid-January, 2016.
- A patrol officer has undergone a surgical procedure to repair a torn rotator cuff and will be absent from duty for about six weeks. He is scheduled for return to light duty the week of February 1, 2016.
- A member of the investigations unit will remain absent from duty for the remainder of 2015 and is scheduled to return in early January.
