MANPOWER REPORT:

- An officer was injured while on-duty when his patrol vehicle struck a stationary object in a parking lot. The surgery was unsuccessful and he underwent a second procedure in mid-October. He is scheduled to return to light duty on February 1st.
- Andrew Kanaskie and Larissa Reggetto began their training with a Field Training Officer in mid-January. The training is expected to last for three months.
- A patrol officer, who is also a member of the Pennsylvania Air National Guard, returned from activate duty in mid-January.
- A patrol officer has undergone a surgical procedure to repair a torn rotator cuff has returned to full, active duty.
- A member of the investigations who underwent a medical procedure has returned to full, active duty.

TRAINING:

- Corporal Abelovsky and Officer Knouss completed a two-day MCSE (truck inspection) recertification training in Harrisburg.
- Newly appointed Officers Kanaskie and Reggetto successfully completed a one-day course in self-defense as well as certification in the use of OC Spray and the Taser.
- Two days of state mandated training for all officers began at the Allentown Police Academy. The training should be completed by early April.

- A nighttime burglary which occurred at the Dollar Tree on Rt. 191 is under investigation.

OTHER INFORMATION:

- A snow emergency was declared after a record snowfall blanketed the Lehigh Valley. There were no significant incidents which occurred as a result of the event.
