MANPOWER REPORT:

- The officer who was injured while on-duty when his patrol vehicle struck a stationary object in a parking lot returned to full, active duty and will retire from this department in June.
- While off duty, a patrol officer injured his ankle and will be on light duty for about six weeks.
- A patrol officer will be absent from duty until February 2017 while on active duty assignment with the Pennsylvania National Guard.

TRAINING:

- Officers Reggetto and Kraemer completed a 1-day course addressing **Sexual Assault Investigations**.
- Officers Kirchner and Anderson completed a 2-day recertification course as departmental **Defensive Tactical Instructors**.
- Spring pistol qualifications were conducted at the Hellertown Gun Club for all officers.
- Sgt. Blake attended a 5- day training session with the *Eastern States Vice Investigators*.
- Officer Lichty and Stanton completed a 3-day certification course to become *Field Training Officers (FTO's)* for new hires.
- Sgt. LaPointe along with Officers Jordan and Frantz attended a 1-day course in *Train/ Vehicle Collision Investigations*.

- Corporals Powell and Abelovsky along with Officers Frantz, Lichty and Stanton attended a 2-day course to become ***Project Lifesaver Instructors***. The program allows officers to apply tracking technology for the search and rescue of individuals with cognitive disorders.
- Officers Lindsay, Frantz, Stanton and Lindsay completed a 1-day course in ***Standardized Field Sobriety Testing (SFST)***.

ARRESTS & INVESTIGATIONS:

- Officer Fox has been assigned as an investigator working under Sgt. Blake in the Vice Investigations unit.

OTHER INFORMATION:

- Sgt. Blake along with Investigator Fox traveled to Puerto Rico to take custody of a suspect charged with her involvement in an armed robbery.
- Sgt. Blake was recognized by the ***VAST Coalition*** for his efforts to assist those who have been forced into the sex trades.
