MANPOWER REPORT:

- In March a patrol officer was injured after being struck by a vehicle which failed to stop at a stop sign, striking the officer who was directing traffic. The officer is undergoing therapy for his injuries and has been assigned to light duty status.
- An officer recovering at home after a non-work related medical procedure has returned to full, active duty.
- An officer was injured during a training exercise was on light duty for several weeks and as returned to full, active duty.
- An officer was injured in an off-duty accident and has been assigned to light duty status.
- Two police patrol candidates successfully completed the written, physical agility, oral interview and background investigations and were conditionally appointed as members of this department. One of the candidates is Act 120 certified and the other is scheduled to attend the Allentown Police Academy in January 2019.
