MANPOWER REPORT:

- In March, 2018 a patrol officer was injured after being struck by a vehicle which failed to stop at a stop sign, striking the officer who was directing traffic. The officer is undergoing therapy for his injuries and has been assigned to light duty status.
- A patrol officer was injured during a training exercise has returned to full, active duty.
- A patrol officer who was involved in a critical incident remains absent from duty.
- A patrol officer is receiving treatment for a non-work related knee injury and is absent from duty.
- A supervising officer was activated by his military unit and is not expected to return to active duty until mid-2020.
- An officer was injured while off duty and is receiving medical treatment.
- Officer Robert Stametz was assigned the position of Acting Corporal until a permanent appointment is accomplished.
- Three officers were conditionally appointed to this department by the Board of Commissioners after having completed written and oral examinations and an extensive background investigation. Each of the three then successfully completed psychological and physical examination. One candidate will begin working with a Field Training Officer while the other two, who are not Act 120 certified, will begin training at the Allentown Police Academy in January.

TRAINING:

- All active duty officers are completing fall patrol rifle qualifications.
- Sgt. LaPointe and Off. Frantz completed three days of instruction as department accident reconstruction specialists.
