

BETHLEHEM TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT

MANPOWER REPORT:

- In March, 2018 a patrol officer was injured after being struck by a vehicle which failed to stop at a stop sign, striking the officer who was directing traffic. The officer is undergoing therapy for his injuries and has been assigned to light duty status.
- A patrol officer was injured during a training exercise and remains on light duty. He is expected to return to active duty in early November.
- A patrol officer who was involved in a critical incident remains absent from duty.
- A patrol officer is receiving treatment for a non-work related knee injury and is absent from duty.
- A supervising officer was activated by his military unit and is not expected to return to active duty until mid-2020.

TRAINING:

- All active duty officers completed fall handgun and TASER qualifications.
- All active duty officers are completing fall patrol rifle qualifications.
- Patrol officers Kraemer, Kanaskie, Malikin and Lindsay completed a one-day course to be certified to field test drugs.
- Departmental firearms instructors Lichty and Beck completed a two-day course as departmental armorers.

ARRESTS & INVESTIGATIONS:

• A domestic issue transitioned into a mental health issue and resulted in a subject barricading himself inside of a home for about three hours. The incident was resolved without the use of force or an arrest.

OTHER INFORMATION:

- Officer Kanaskie has begun the second year of the Boy Scout Explorer Program
 which invites select high school students from FHS & BAVTS to learn about
 police functions and responsibilities.
- Officer Lichty received a 'thank you' letter from the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local Union 126, for the manner in which he addressed a complaint.
