***MANPOWER REPORT:***

- In March, 2018 a patrol officer was injured after being struck by a vehicle which failed to stop at a stop sign, striking the officer who was directing traffic. The officer is undergoing therapy for his injuries and has been assigned to light duty status.
- A patrol officer was injured during a training exercise and remains on light duty.
- A patrol officer who was involved in a critical incident remains absent from duty.

**TRAINING:**

- Corporal Anderson along with Investigators Fox and Stevens attended a seminar for suicide investigations as well as SIDS/ infant homicide investigations.
- Investigator Stevens attended a one-week recertification course as the department's polygraph operator.
- Officers Kanaskie, Willams and Ebner attended a seminar addressing Medical Marijuana and the PSP Corporal Kelly shooting.

***ARRESTS & INVESTIGATIONS:***

- An arrest was made after a strong arm robbery at NCC.
- A citizen was charged after an hours long standoff on 10<sup>th</sup> Street near Brader St. He was charged with threatening behavior while in possession of a handgun. Our department was assisted in convincing the subject to peacefully surrender by members of the PA Police SERT team.

- One man who was riding a motorcycle was killed in a two-vehicle collision at the intersection of Freemansburg Ave. and Second St.,
