MANPOWER REPORT:

- A patrol officer who was involved in a critical incident remains absent from duty.
- A patrol officer is receiving treatment for a non-work related knee injury and is absent from duty.
- A supervising officer remains activated by his military unit and his return to duty has been delayed due to the Covid-19 virus.
- An officer is receiving treatment for a non-work related injury and cannot return to light duty due to the pandemic.
- Two police cadets continue training at the Allentown Police Academy.
- A patrol officer has been deployed by the military and will remain on active duty until spring of 2021.

TRAINING:

- Scheduled training was cancelled/postponed due to the Covid-19 virus.

ARRESTS & INVESTIGATIONS:

- A young township residence riding a bicycle on Freemansburg Avenue near Willow Park Road was struck by a motor vehicle and remains hospitalized in critical condition. The driver of the vehicle was charged with Aggravated Assault, DUI and related offenses.

OTHER INFORMATION:

- All Northampton County police departments signed on to a Mutual Aid Agreement allowing for any department's officers to assist in the patrol of any other department should the occasion arise due to the recent pandemic.
