MANPOWER REPORT:

- A patrol officer who was involved in a critical incident remains absent from duty.
- A patrol officer is receiving treatment for a non-work related knee injury and is absent from duty.
- A supervising officer remains activated by his military unit and is not expected to return to active duty until mid-2020.
- An officer is receiving treatment for a non-work related injury and has returned to light-duty status.

TRAINING:

- All officers are currently completing annual mandatory in-service training. The training consists of four separate subjects and is being conducted on line and on station.
- Sgt. Powell completed a one-day training session involving the investigation of Financial Crimes.
- Officers Lichty and Beck completed two days of training as departmental armorers to retain their certification.
- Officers Frantz and Knouss completed 2 days of training as inspectors for commercial vehicles.

ARRESTS & INVESTIGATIONS:

- The burglary of a residential structure in December 2019 was cleared by arrest.

- A township couple donated funding sufficient to purchase one bullet resistant vest for an officer.
