MANPOWER REPORT:

- A patrol officer who was involved in a critical incident remains absent from duty.
- A patrol officer is receiving treatment for a nonwork related knee injury and is absent from duty.
- A supervising officer remains activated by his military unit and his return to duty has been delayed due to the Covid-19 virus. He is expected to return to duty in August.
- An officer who was receiving treatment for a non-work related injury has returned to active duty.
- Two police cadets completed training at the Allentown Police Academy and have been assigned for additional training and experience with a Field Training Officer (FTO). The FTO program lasts for about 3 months.
- A patrol officer has been deployed by the military and will remain on active duty until spring of 2021.
- A patrol officer has completed his one-year probationary period and continues with a regular patrol assignment.

TRAINING:

- Sgt. Powell completed a one-week training course with the FBI entitled Law Enforcement Executive Development.
- Spring handgun qualifications were conducted at the Hellertown Gun Club for all officers.

ARRESTS & INVESTIGATIONS:

- A high speed, rollover crash on Easton Avenue and Santee Road resulted in the arrest of the driver for DUI.
