MANPOWER REPORT:

- A patrol officer who was involved in a critical incident remains absent from duty.
- A patrol officer is receiving treatment for a non-work related knee injury and is absent from duty.
- A supervising officer remains activated by his military unit and his return to duty has been delayed due to the Covid-19 virus.
- An officer is receiving treatment for a non-work related injury and cannot return to light duty due to the pandemic.
- Two police cadets continue training at the Allentown Police Academy.

TRAINING:

- Off. Gonzalez completed a one-day Standardized Field Sobriety Test (SFST) course.
- Acting Cpl. Stametz completed a one-week PSU sponsored course entitled POSIT, which is designed for newly appointed supervisors.
- All other scheduled training was cancelled/postponed due to the Covid-19 virus.

ARRESTS & INVESTIGATIONS:

- It is significant to note that we are investigating three drug related overdose deaths.

OTHER INFORMATION:

- All Northampton County police departments signed on to a Mutual Aid Agreement allowing for any department's officers to assist in the patrol of any other department should the occasion arise due to the recent pandemic.
