MANPOWER REPORT:

- A patrol officer who was involved in a critical incident remains absent from duty.
- A patrol officer is receiving treatment for a nonwork related knee injury and is absent from duty.
- A supervising officer remains activated by his military unit and his return to duty has been delayed due to the Covid-19 virus.
- An officer is receiving treatment for a non-work related injury and cannot return to light duty due to the pandemic.
- Two police cadets continue training at the Allentown Police Academy and are scheduled to graduate in June, 2020..
- A patrol officer has been deployed by the military and will remain on active duty until spring of 2021.

TRAINING:

- Department TASER instructors Officers Brehm and Lindsay completed a one-day recertification course.
- Officers completed semi-annual firearms qualifications and pistol training at the Hellertown Gun Club.

ARRESTS & INVESTIGATIONS:

- An investigation into the shipment of marijuana from Canada by way of Fed-Ex culminated with the arrest of a 25 y.o. male, the recovery of many pounds of marijuana and over \$95,000 in cash. The marijuana was delivered at a private residence in the Miller Heights section of 8th Street.
- A 29 y.o. male fired a pellet gun at three persons in the parking lot of the Sunoco gas station on Easton Avenue, striking one victim four times. The suspect fled the scene and was apprehended in New York after exiting his vehicle while holding the pellet gun and then being shot by police. The suspect will be arrested after his release from the hospital.
