PennDOT is advancing a project to improve the SR 22 (Lehigh Valley Thruway) and SR 191 (Nazareth Pike) interchange in Bethlehem Township, Northampton County.

The project will enhance traffic flow and safety at the interchange, which connects local communities, businesses, and the greater Lehigh Valley Region.

Proposed Project Improvements Include:

- Extending the SR 22 EB deceleration and WB acceleration lane lengths
- Increasing shoulder widths on SR 22
- Replacing the SR 22 bridges over the railroad and SR 191
- Adding a second through lane in both directions on SR 191
- Adding sidewalk on each side of SR 191
- Adding designated turn lanes throughout the corridor
- Realigning Brodhead Road, including new at-grade railroad crossing and bridge

These improvements will support future growth and increased traffic in the interchange while improving safety and mobility for all users.
