## MOTION <br> A MOTION AUTHORIZING THE ADVERTISING OF AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS FOR THE INSTALLATION, INSPECTION, AND ON-GOING MAINTENANCE OF ON-LOT SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS; REQUIRING REGISTRATION OF SEPTAGE PUMPER/HAULER AND CERTIFIED INSPECTION BUSINESSES WITH BETHLEHEM TOWNSHIP; AND FURTHER, PROVIDING FOR IMPOSITION OF PENALTIES FOR NONCOMPLIANCE AND APPEALS FOR HARDSHIP SITUATIONS

A MOTION AUTHORIZING THE ADVERTISING OF AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BETHLEHEM, CHAPTER 187, PROPERTY, ABANDONED AND FORECLOSED; PROVIDING AMENDMENTS TO SECTION 187-2, DEFINITIONS, AND SECTION 187-9, VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH

Solicitor Broughal said this ordinance amends the fees and penalties from civil to criminal. Mr. Gallagher needed more clarification of the definitions in Section 1.

Upon motion (Gallagher-Hudak), the Board of Commissioners voted unanimously by voice vote to table this motion. Ms. Beatty was absent.

Mr. Hudak thought these regulations already existed and asked what the difference was. Solicitor Broughal said this ordinance was drafted by the municipal authority and could not provide an answer.

Upon motion (Hudak-Lawrence), the Board of Commissioners voted unanimously by voice vote to authorize the advertisement of an ordinance establishing regulations for the installation, inspection, and on-going maintenance of on-lot sewage disposal systems; requiring registration of septage pumper/hauler and certified inspection businesses with Bethlehem Township; and further, providing for imposition of penalties for noncompliance and appeals for hardship situations. Ms. Beatty was absent.
